Bond Projects Underway

APS is working through the winter on several bond-funded construction projects.

Construction of a new Aurora Hills Middle School is nearly complete. To allow additional time for staff to move into the new building over winter break, the school is following a modified calendar. Aurora Hills students will return to classes in their brand new building on Monday, Jan. 9.

Other bond projects underway or scheduled to start this school year include whole building remodels at Altura, Elkhart and Lansing elementary schools, a new water piping system at Lyn Knoll Elementary, and roof and swimming pool building repairs at Hinkley High School.

In addition to construction projects, the bond is funding more than \$13.6 million in technology improvements, including new computers, computer network and telephone system upgrades, and cutting-edge classroom technology.
