To be eligible for screening, children must be 3 or 4 years old on or before Oct. 1, 2012. Children do not need to be present at the time of screening. All families must participate in the screening process to be eligible for the Colorado Preschool Program or tuition-based preschool. Due to limited program space, screening does not guarantee placement.
