The Aurora Public Schools Board of Education will have four seats open this fall.

ABOUT THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

The APS Board of Education is a seven-member group elected to establish policies for the school district. Board members are elected at large and serve four-year terms. The board addresses the concerns of the local community while working within the framework of state and federal laws. This includes approving curricula and instructional materials, evaluating the superintendent and adopting the annual budget.

ABOUT THE ELECTION

Board candidates run on a non-partisan basis and do not need to be educators. The election will be held on **November 5, 2013**.
