To be eligible for the preschool program, children must be 3 or 4 years old on or before Oct. 1, 2016. In order for your child to be considered, a parent or legal guardian must attend the preschool screening process. Your child must be present for the screening and your child's birth certificate is required. If your name does not appear on the child's birth certificate, you MUST bring legal documentation of guardianship.
